Peter Rogers has served as Gordon McKay Professor of Environmental Engineering at Harvard University, since 1974. He is currently a Visiting Professor at the Global Asia Center, National University of Singapore. He has carried out extensive field and model studies on population, water and energy resources, and environmental problems in Costa Rica, Pakistan, India, China, the Philippines, Bangladesh, and to a lesser extent, in 25 other countries. He is co-author with Susan Leal of a book entitled Running Out of Water, published by Palgrave/Macmillan in August 2010. Recent books include An Introduction to Sustainable Development (with K. F. Jalal and J. A. Boyd), Earthscan, 2008, and Water Crisis: Myth or Reality (with M. R. Llamas and L. Martínez-Cortina), Taylor & Francis, 2006. Professor Rogers is Senior Advisor to the Global Water Partnership, as well as other prestigious organizations. Most recently, he received the 2010 Julian Hinds Award from the Environmental Water Resources Institute (EWRI) of the American Society of Civil Engineers. The citation read: “For four decades of pioneering leadership, beginning with the Harvard Water Program, in water resource systems engineering, infrastructure planning and management, and water policy with particular concern for economic development and problems in developing regions.”
